



## **Housing Authority of the County of Dauphin**

## **Public Housing Application Fact Sheet**

- 1. The HACD will accept pre-applications for the Public Housing program online at <a href="https://www.dauphinhousing.org">www.dauphinhousing.org</a> beginning June 1, 2015. The website also contains a Spanish version of the Pre-application. We no longer accept paper Pre-applications.
- 2. Pre-applications for <u>FAMILY HOUSING</u> will only be accepted for a five (5) day period beginning at 9:00 AM on June 1, 2015 and ending at 5:00 PM on June 5, 2015.
- 3. Also, beginning at the same time and date, pre-applications for <u>ELDERLY AND/OR PERMANENTLY DISABLED PERSONS</u> will be accepted until further notice without a close date. This includes individuals and families whose head of household, co-head, spouse or sole member are at least fifty (50) years of age or permanently disabled.
- 4. Before you begin the Pre-application, make sure you know the names, Social Security numbers and birth dates of all household members.
- 5. You must complete the entire Pre-application process for the Pre-application to be valid.
- 6. You must be at least 18 years old to submit a Pre-application for the Public Housing Program.
- 7. While filling out the online Pre-application you will be asked to specify the area for which you are applying. You will be given three (3) options from which to choose-Southern Dauphin County, Northern Dauphin County or both Southern and Northern.
- 8. Southern Dauphin County sites are located in Steelton, Highspire, Middletown, and Swatara Township.
- 9. Northern Dauphin County sites are located in Lykens, Williamstown, Gratz and Wiconisco.
- 10. If you have already submitted a Pre-application for Northern Dauphin County and want to be considered for Southern Dauphin County you must submit a separate Pre-application.
- 11. Persons who do not have access to a computer to complete the Pre-application may consult our Public Notice for a list of organizations with computer resources available. You may also visit your local library to complete an online Pre-application.
- 12. At the end of the online Pre-application process you will be given a confirmation number to confirm that your Pre-application has been successfully submitted. Be prepared to write this number down.
